

Terms and Conditions

ACNT University Australia Scholarships

The ACNT Scholarship covers tuition fees for 1 new student covering:

20% Scholarship of One year for courses commencing Trimester 1 2018 in any of our full time, on-campus courses including:

Bachelor of Health Science (Naturopathy)
Bachelor of Health Science (Nutritional Medicine)
Bachelor of Health Science (Western Herbal Medicine)

OR 20% Scholarship of One trimester for courses commencing in Trimester 1, 2018 in any of our full time, on-campus courses including:

Diploma of Health Science

The scholarship recipient must meet all entry requirements of the course and have submitted a course application form.

The scholarship will cover 20% of 1 year of tuition fees for Bachelor Degrees, or 20% of 1 trimester of tuition fees for the Diploma of Health Science course.

By accepting the scholarship the recipient must agree to take part in marketing activities and college events (such as Open Days, Information Evenings, Workshops etc), contribute to the college's social media channels and provide testimonials as required.

Scholarships are for new, full-time students only. The recipient will be required to commence studies in T1, 2018.

Deferral or withdrawal of studies will result in forfeit of the remainder of the scholarship award (or the entire award if the studies have not yet commenced).

Should a scholarship recipient intend to transition to part-time mode at any point during their studies, the University reserves the right to discontinue the scholarship award.

The scholarship recipient is expected to excel academically, and their performance will be monitored each study period. A failure to meet academic obligations may result in forfeit of the scholarship award. Subsequent fees for repeating a failed subject will be the responsibility of the student.

Scholarship award is attributable for Bachelor Degrees as a fee credit for the first year of study only and is non-transferable.

Scholarship award is attributable for Master, Diploma and Graduate Diploma courses as a fee credit for the first trimester of study only and is non-transferable.

At the discretion of college administration, scholarships can and may be split and awarded as partial value or not awarded at all, depending on the overall quality of submissions.
